Court to Remain Open Despite Possible Government Shutdown

Please be advised that the United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico will remain open in the event of a shutdown, should Congress fail to approve, on October 1, 2013, a temporary spending bill to keep the government running until further notice.

Our Court will continue normal operations so that all cases, including civil and criminal jury trials, will be heard as scheduled. The Clerk's Office will remain open as well.

The Court is actively monitoring the situation and will continue to keep members of the bar and the public abreast of any pertinent developments.
