
Final Implementation Phase of the Civil/Criminal Accounting Module

Early this Summer, the Clerk's Office Finance Section began the process of implementing the Civil/Criminal Accounting Module (CCAM), a system which replaces all judiciary financial data systems nationwide. This process is scheduled to conclude on August, 2010. See, Notice from the Clerk No. 10-09. Throughout the entire process, the Finance Section has and will continue to fulfill its role and responsibilities, expeditiously processing requests and answering messages, as customary.

In keeping with the Court's commitment to keep the bar and the public apprised of the progress of CCAM's implementation, we have commenced conversion and reconciliation of data activities to be finalized on **August 5, 2010**. During this brief period, we request that attorneys, vendors, and the general public allow a message/request response time of two working days. The Finance Section staff will continue to tend to regular business, including messages and requests, throughout this time.

Once operational, CCAM will enhance performance of accounting, budget and financial activities for the overall benefit of the bench, the bar and the public.
