**CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT PANEL**  
**ATTORNEY PAYMENT SYSTEM (CJA 6.1.5) UPGRADE**

On May 2010, the U.S. District Court for the District of Puerto Rico began the process of implementing the Criminal Justice Act Panel Attorney Payment System (CJA 6.1.5). This web-based program, which modernizes the current application (CJA 3.2.01), is being implemented by the Accounting and Financial Systems Division of (AFSD) of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO). Twelve courts successfully implemented the CJA 6.1.5 application on May 3, 2010.

The conversion process for the remaining courts, including the District of Puerto Rico, will commence on Friday, August 13, 2010. The new system is expected to “go live” on Monday, August 16, 2010. **Only partial data will be converted from CJA 3.2.01 to CJA 6.1.5, thus, the upgrade may temporarily delay payments as vouchers will be screened for status prior to being entered and processed in the new system.** Attorneys are encouraged to forward this information to experts awaiting compensation under the CJA.
