Scheduled CM/ECF Outage due to Server Replacement

In order to continue to meet the case filing and case management needs of the public, litigants, the bar, the Court, and other users, the Judiciary's Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system is constantly upgraded with new software modules and hardware components. CM/ECF has evolved exponentially since its inception and its oversight and development, including data migration strategies, are of critical national importance to the Judiciary. Accordingly, the time has come to update the District of Puerto Rico's CM/ECF server.

Please take notice that the Court will be replacing the District CM/ECF server, which includes migration, testing and certification of all data, beginning Friday, September 17, 2010. Due to replacement of our server, **CM/ECF will be temporarily unavailable for all users between Friday, September 17, 2010, at 5:00 p.m., and Sunday, September 19, 2010, at 5:00 p.m.**

Replacement of our server is of critical importance to the Court's operations and cannot be postponed. We request that you plan your filings accordingly. Our staff will be available to assist you through this process. **Please call (787)772-3060 for emergency filings only.** You will be prompted to leave a voice mail and will be contacted by Operations Manager Lida Isis Egelé.
